

Redhill

This development will be the first significant housing project in the south east of England to use an environmentally-friendly biomass boiler system to provide heating and hot water to apartment blocks comprising 250 homes.

Biomass is a carbon neutral method of producing heat, and it is estimated that its introduction will save over 500 tonnes of carbon dioxide each year compared to a conventional gas fired heating system. The system is fired using locally sourced wood chip which is a sustainable and renewable fuel source. The associated lower running costs will also significantly cut residents annual heating costs.
